





# -Our Monastery-

St. Joseph's Abbey is home to a community of Trappist monks. Following the Benedictine tradition of ora et labora (pray and work), the monks pursue a simple life of contemplative prayer, manual labor and hospitality. Along with the beer they make at the brewery the monks make jams and jellies at Trappist Preserves and liturgical vestments at the Holy Rood Guild. They also offer retreats and have church services throughout the day which are open to the public.
